The paper is generally well written and organized. The results presented in the paper seem correct, and potentially useful in practice. The techniques employed to tackle the problems are generally standard with some novelties. The paper can be accepted for publication subject to some necessary minor changes as below:

Comments:

- 1) The review on existing studies is not enough. It has been found that few reviewed references are published in recent years; therefore, the motivation of this work, that is, why to explore system continuance success of the local electronic government, can't be justified.
- 2) In the research model talked about at the beginning of Section 2, the IS success model includes six variables; however, all the variables are used in this research, except net benefit (NBF). The reason is suggested to be simply explained.
- 3) It is recommended to replace the comma with decimal point in Table 2.
- 4) In the paragraph above Table 2, it is mentioned the path coefficients of eight hypotheses such as INQ→PFX and PFX→SYU were the significant paths, but from Table 4, SYU→SCS was also the significant path.
- 5) In the Discussion section, authors stated that INQ→PFX, SYU→USF, and USF→SCS have the large f^2 (> 0.35); however, from Table 4, SYU→SCS, instead of SYU→USF, has the large f^2 .
- 6) In the second last line of Page 6, what is "od" referring to?
- 7) In the Conclusion, the variable "PCC" should be "FCC".
- 8) Except References [5] and [15], all the other references are relatively outdated; therefore, it is suggested to cite more up-to-date references from mainstream journals.
- 9) English presentation should be further polished. For example, "Referring to the citizens' needs have become the focus of attention", "Although identifying the factors that influence the adoption of a particular technology is an important indicator for the success of an information system", "the proposed question of the study was about what are factors that affect the system continuance success" and "the user expectations and preferences...did not the main attention of the stakeholders" are ill-formed expressions.
